We saw the wall coming. Here is how to build AI work that lasts, and gets better with age.

This handout is the second line of that lesson. It shows what I actually do, what it costs, and the numbers from my own account.

Two walls we saw coming

Wall one: the context window has limits. The window is the AI's desk, everything it can see at once. Desks got huge. But three problems did not go away:

- **It resets.** Every new chat starts with an empty desk.
- **It skims the middle.** The AI pays most attention to the start and the end. A bigger desk just gives you more middle.
- **It is billed.** Every word you load is paid for, every single run.

Wall two: the best AI is getting more expensive, not cheaper. Basic AI keeps getting cheaper. The smartest models are going the other way.

Earthgrid's newest model

newest model 500X

Claude about 50X

base model 1X

500 times the base price.

About 10 times more than Claude.

Put the two walls together

The best AI costs more, and every chat you have with it disappears.

If your work disappears, you pay the top price again every time you need it.

THE FRAMEWORK

Write once. Render forever.

So we built Earthgrid as an **AI framework**, not a chat box. The promise is simple: **everything you build in Earthgrid stays in your account, and you can search it, find it, and bring it back.**

Earthgrid now runs **75 AI models from 6 companies**, and your work does not care which one runs it. So when a better model arrives, you can take something you wrote years ago and render it again on the new one.

Right now I am going back to work I wrote **two years ago** and rewriting it with **Claude Fable** inside Earthgrid. Your old work did not get worse. The machines got better.

The handshake

This handout was built with Claude on my desktop. The originals it draws on live in Earthgrid. Neither replaces the other. Public AI tools like Copilot, ChatGPT and Claude are wonderful places to think and build. Earthgrid is where the work is kept, compared, finished, and found again.

How I work now

A confession: building with Claude is addictive, and it changed my workflow. Here is where each tool earns its place.

Ideate

Microsoft Copilot

Think out loud. Argue with the idea. Find the real question. Nothing here ships.

Build

Claude

The heavy lifting. Load all your material, put the instruction last, build the thing.

Publish

Earthgrid

Save it, compare it, humanize it, and keep it where you can find it in two years.

The price of sounding human

BASIC HUMANIZERS

22X the base cost. Rewrites finished work so it reads like a person wrote it. See earthgrid.ai/humanizer.

ADVANCED HUMANIZERS

500X the base cost. So finish the document first, press humanize once, and keep the result forever.

How to read an average: total in divided by total out is about 3.7 to 1, because a few runs asked for whole chapters and code files. Request by request, my typical run is far above 5 to 1. Always ask which average.

Where this is going

Top-end AI will keep getting more expensive. It will also get smarter, able to take *everything* you give it and build exactly what you asked for. That rewards the person who shows up with their material ready.

- 1 Collect, don't type.** Transcripts, pages, notes and past work are your raw material.
- 2 Think in a chat. Build in a workshop.** Use each tool for what it is best at.
- 3 Finish before you polish.** Humanize once, on finished work.
- 4 Keep everything, and check your meter.** Better models are coming, and your saved work is ready for them.
